- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 44-06-03 and 44-06-03.1 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to bonds of notaries public.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 44-06-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
  - **44-06-03. Oath and bond of notary public Approval of bond.** Each notary public, before entering upon the duties of the office, shall take the oath prescribed for civil officers and give to the state a bond in the penal sum of seven thousand five hundred dollars conditioned for the faithful discharge of the duties of the office. Such The bond may must be furnished by a surety or bonding company authorized to do business in this state or by one or more sureties, and is subject to approval by the secretary of state.
- SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 44-06-03.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 44-06-03.1. Notice by surety to secretary of state of claim against bond. If a
  surety or bonding company giving a bond under section 44-06-03 receives a claim against that
  bond with respect to a notary public, that surety or bonding company shall notify the secretary
  of state of the outcome of said the claim.
