- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 20.1-02 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the introduction of nonnative fish species; and to provide a penalty.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 20.1-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 Introduction of nonnative fish species Approval of legislative assembly required
 - **Penalty.** The director may not introduce any nonnative fish species into any body of water
- 8 located in this state without first obtaining the prior approval of the legislative assembly. In
- 9 determining whether to grant approval, the legislative assembly shall solicit information and
- 10 testimony from the states and provinces of the Dominion of Canada in which is located a
- 11 portion of the same drainage basin as the body of water into which the nonnative fish species is
- 12 to be introduced. In addition, the legislative assembly shall solicit information from the
- 13 American fisheries society concerning the introduction. Any person who willfully violates this
- 14 section is guilty of a class C felony.
