## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 54-06 of the North Dakota Century Code iscreated and enacted as follows:

Attendance of state employees at legislative standing and conference committee meetings. A state employee may not testify or be present at a meeting of a legislative standing committee or conference committee unless that employee has been requested to testify or attend by a member of the committee or the sponsor of the bill being considered by the committee, or unless the state employee is attending the meeting on the employee's own time.

**SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 54-35-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

**54-35-08.** Recommended legislation may be required in advance. The council may require that any recommendation for legislation that is to be presented by any department, board, commission, agency, officer, official, or employee of the state desiring the consideration of the council, be presented to it at least sixty days in advance of any regular session. An executive agency or the judicial branch may not request the introduction of any bill or file a bill for introduction unless the entity receives the approval of a legislator to sponsor the bill. The director of the budget, however, may file bills making appropriations to implement the budget recommended by the governor, and the supreme court may file a bill implementing the budget
