1 A BILL for an Act relating to facilities for viewing certain motion pictures or other entertainment.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 3 SECTION 1. Requirements of facilities for viewing motion pictures.
 - 1. A person may not own, rent, lease, manage, or exercise control of any portion of a commercial building if that portion contains:
 - a. Any partition between subdivisions of a room or area which has an aperture that is designed or constructed to facilitate a sexual act as defined in section 12.1-20-02 between individuals on either side of the partition.
 - b. A room, booth, stall, or partitioned portion of a room specifically offered to individuals for a fee, other than pay toilets, or as an incident to performing sexual acts or for the viewing of motion pictures or other forms of entertainment, if access to that enclosed area is through a door, curtain, or portal through which one cannot view the activity taking place within the enclosure, unless the room, booth, stall, or partitioned portion of a room has at least one side open to an adjacent public room so that the area inside is visible to individuals in the adjacent public room.
 - 2. In any enclosure described in subsection 1 which has an area for viewing motion pictures or other forms of entertainment, that area must be lighted in a manner that the persons in the area are visible from the adjacent public room. The lighting may not be of an intensity as to prevent the viewing of the motion pictures or other entertainment.
 - 3. This section does not apply to:
 - a. Enclosures that are private offices used by the owners, managers, or persons employed on the premises for attending to the tasks of their employment and

2	fee or for the purpose of viewing motion pictures or other entertainment for a

b. Hotels, motels, apartment complexes, condominiums, or rooming houses.
