- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 65-04-19.1 and 65-04-19.2 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to the workers' compensation premium discount for
- 3 implementing a preapproved risk management program.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 65-04-19.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 amended and reenacted as follows:

65-04-19.1. Premium discount for implementation of preapproved risk

management program. Any employer who implements or maintains risk management

- programs approved by the bureau is entitled to a five percent discount in the annual premium
- 10 the employer must pay to the bureau for the year following the year in which the risk
- 11 management programs are implemented or maintained. The discount in the annual premium is
- 12 fifteen percent for the first five thousand dollars of premium, ten percent for the next fifteen
- 13 thousand dollars of premium, and five percent for the amount of premium in excess of twenty
- 14 thousand dollars. The bureau may not apply the discount to an employer's premium unless the
- bureau has approved the programs implemented by the employer.
- SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 65-04-19.2 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 17 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 18 **65-04-19.2.** State agency participation in risk management program. Before
- 19 November 1, 1995, every Every state agency, institution, and entity employing twenty-five or
- 20 more full-time equivalent employees shall submit to the bureau for approval a written risk
- 21 management program under section 65-04-19.1. Before December 1, 1995, the The bureau
- 22 shall review the program and shall inform the state agency, institution, or entity of any change
- 23 needed to receive the bureau's approval of the program. The state agency, institution, or entity
- 24 shall make the necessary changes and shall implement the approved program before

- 1 January 1, 1996. Beginning with the 1996 calendar year, every state agency, institution, and
- 2 entity that maintains a risk management program approved by the bureau is entitled to a five
- 3 percent <u>an</u> annual premium discount under section 65-04-19.1.
