- 1 A concurrent resolution requesting that the Congress of the United States propose for 2 ratification by the states an amendment to the Constitution of the United States to provide for 3 abolition of the electoral college system and adoption of direct popular vote for election of the 4 President and Vice President. 5 WHEREAS, the electoral college system of electing the President and Vice President of 6 the United States is complex and indirect; and 7 WHEREAS, the electoral college system is inequitable and allows the possibility that a 8 candidate may become President with fewer popular votes than the candidate's opponent; and 9 WHEREAS, the vote of one individual in an election for President and Vice President 10 should count as much as the vote of any other individual; 11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
 - NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

That the Fifty-fifth Legislative Assembly urges the Congress of the United States to propose to the several states for ratification an amendment to the Constitution of the United States to provide for abolition of the electoral college system and adoption of direct popular vote for election of the President and Vice President; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of State forward copies of this resolution to the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, the President of the United States Senate, and the members of the North Dakota Congressional Delegation.
