- 1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the feasibility and desirability 2 of consolidating counties.
- 3 WHEREAS, proposals to consolidate counties of the state have been discussed 4 frequently and considered by the Legislative Assembly; and
- 5 WHEREAS, because there are potential advantages and disadvantages of 6 consolidating counties, thoughtful review and study is needed to fully examine the legal and 7 administrative issues necessary to make a decision in the best interest of all citizens of the 8 state; and
- WHEREAS, a comprehensive study of consolidation of counties will allow consideration 10 of the complex issues that must be addressed regarding consolidation and allow an opportunity 11 for input from citizens;
  - NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:
  - That the Legislative Council study the feasibility and desirability of consolidating counties; and
- 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and 17 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to 18 the Fifty-sixth Legislative Assembly.
