- 1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the feasibility and desirability 2 of licensing high pressure boiler operators. 3 WHEREAS, the operation of high pressure boilers and other high pressure vessels may 4 pose significant safety risks; and 5 WHEREAS, North Dakota does not license high pressure boiler operators; and 6 WHEREAS, a comprehensive study of the actual risks from not licensing high pressure 7 boiler operators, the availability of training programs, and other states' laws and practices may 8 be appropriate before implementing licensure requirements for high pressure boiler operators; 9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE 10 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:
 - That the Legislative Council study the feasibility and desirability of licensing high pressure boiler operators; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the Fifty-sixth Legislative Assembly.
