SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4039

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the feasibility and desirability
2 of implementing voter registration.

3 **WHEREAS**, North Dakota is the only state that does not require voter registration; and

4 **WHEREAS**, the reduction in the number of voting precincts has increased the number
5 of voters eligible to vote at each polling place, which may present greater opportunities for voter
6 fraud; and

7 **WHEREAS**, detailed study of the feasibility and desirability of implementing a voter
8 registration system may be necessary because the impacts of the federal motor voter
9 legislation are not fully known;

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE**
11 **HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:**

12 That the Legislative Council study the feasibility and desirability of implementing voter
13 registration; and

14 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
15 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
16 the Fifty-sixth Legislative Assembly.
