**HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3033**

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the effects of managed health  
2 care on the future viability of the health care delivery system in rural North Dakota.

3 **WHEREAS**, the health care delivery system in rural North Dakota has been under  
4 increasing economic pressure for several years; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the system of health care financing is undergoing fundamental changes  
6 that may further adversely affect rural health care providers; and

7 **WHEREAS**, many rural areas have had a longstanding difficulty in recruiting and  
8 retaining health care personnel; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the continued viability of the health care delivery system in rural North  
10 Dakota is a necessary condition for economic development;

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**  
12 **OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

13 That the Legislative Council study the effects of managed health care on the future  
14 viability of the health care delivery system in rural North Dakota; and

15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and  
16 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to  
17 the Fifty-sixth Legislative Assembly.
