

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3053

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the feasibility and desirability
2 of providing nursing services in the public schools of this state.

3 **WHEREAS**, students in kindergarten through grade 12 frequently require the
4 administration of pharmaceuticals during school hours; and

5 **WHEREAS**, a significant number of special needs students require medical attention
6 that is beyond the scope of training normally given to teachers and school district
7 administrators; and

8 **WHEREAS**, all students and school district personnel are susceptible to unanticipated
9 injuries and illnesses and could benefit from having prompt attention by trained medical
10 personnel; and

11 **WHEREAS**, all students and school district personnel could benefit from the promotion
12 of health and wellness concepts; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the potential contribution of nurses to the health, safety, and welfare of this
14 state's students and school district personnel has not been adequately examined;

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**
16 **OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

17 That the Legislative Council study the feasibility and desirability of providing nursing
18 services in the public schools of this state.

19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
20 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
21 the Fifty-sixth Legislative Assembly.
