1	A concurrent resolution to create and enact a new section to article VIII of the Constitution of
2	North Dakota, relating to free public education; to repeal sections 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 of article VIII
3	of the Constitution of North Dakota, relating to the establishment and maintenance of a system
4	of free public schools, the branches of knowledge to be taught in those schools, and to the
5	support of those schools; and to provide an effective date.
6	STATEMENT OF INTENT
7	This amendment creates a new section to article VIII of the Constitution of North Dakota
8	relating to the duties of the legislative assembly with respect to a system of free public
9	education. The amendment also repeals sections 1 2, 3, 4, and 5 of article VIII of the
10	Constitution of North Dakota, relating to the legislative duties to provide for a system of free
11	public schools, the branches of knowledge to be taught in those schools, and to the support of
12	schools, and provides that these changes will take effect August 1, 1999.
13	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE
14	SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
15	That the following proposed creation of a new section to article VIII and the repeal of
16	sections 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 of article VIII of the Constitution of North Dakota are agreed to and
17	must be submitted to the qualified electors of North Dakota at the primary election to be held in
18	1998, in accordance with section 16 of Article IV of the Constitution of North Dakota.
19	SECTION 1. A new section to article VIII of the Constitution North Dakota is created
20	and enacted as follows:
21	The legislative assembly shall provide for a uniform system of free public education.
22	The legislative assembly shall take other steps necessary to prevent illiteracy and to provide fo
23	special education and vocational education. Schools and institutions so established must be
24	free from sectarian control. No money raised for the support of public schools of the state may

be appropriated to or used for the support of any sectarian school.

- 1 **SECTION 2. REPEAL.** Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 of article VIII of the Constitution of
- 2 North Dakota are repealed.
- 3 **SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.** If approved by the electors, this measure becomes
- 4 effective on August 1, 1999.
