1	A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the interrelationship of the
2	postjudgment issues of child support and visitation, including the accountability of both parents
3	to honor divorce orders and the development of a parenting education program that addresses
4	the impact of divorce on children.
5	WHEREAS, nationwide, there are more than one million children each year whose
6	parents are involved in divorce proceedings; and
7	WHEREAS, research indicates that children of divorcing couples are at a greater risk
8	than children in two-parent families for a range of problems, from depression to poor grades to
9	substance abuse; and
10	WHEREAS, at least 10 states, including lowa and Illinois, have enacted legislation that
11	provides for either voluntary or mandated education programs for divorcing parents; and
12	WHEREAS, each child has a right to be guided, nurtured, and supported emotionally,
13	physically, and financially by both parents regardless of the parents' marital status; and
14	WHEREAS, concerns have been expressed that there are inequities in the enforcement
15	of visitation orders and child support obligations;
16	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE
17	HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:
18	That the Legislative Council study the interrelationship of the postjudgment issues of
19	child support and visitation, including the accountability of both parents to honor divorce orders
20	and the development of a parenting education program that addresses the impact of divorce on
21	children; and
22	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
23	recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
