1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study occupational and professional 2 licensing entities with an emphasis on methods to privatize licensing entities. 3 WHEREAS, during the 1995-96 interim, the Legislative Council conducted a 4 comprehensive study of all boards, committees, commissions, and councils of state 5 government; and 6 WHEREAS, because of the large scope of that study, the interim committee was unable 7 to fully research areas in which other states are attempting to consolidate or eliminate 8 occupational and professional licensing entities; and 9 WHEREAS, there are approximately 40 occupational and professional licensing entities 10 for which the Legislative Assembly has oversight and legal responsibility; and 11 WHEREAS, other states are attempting to address the problem of the growing number 12 of state licensing entities through privatization of those entities; and 13 WHEREAS, a number of occupational and professional licensing entities in this state have demonstrated an interest in working with establishing models of privatization of licensing 14 15 functions; 16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE 17 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN: 18 That the Legislative Council study occupational and professional licensing entities with 19 an emphasis on methods to privatize licensing entities; and 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Council report its findings and 21 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to 22 the Fifty-sixth Legislative Assembly.
