**ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1017**

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the adjutant  
2 general.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the  
5 funds as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in  
6 the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal  
7 funds and other income, to the adjutant general's office for the purpose of defraying the  
8 expenses of the adjutant general's office, for the biennium beginning July 1, 1997, and ending  
9 June 30, 1999, as follows:

23 **SECTION 2. SPECIAL FUNDS.** The amount of \$60,000, or so much of the amount as  
24 is necessary, included in the estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act, is to be spent

1 from the national guard tuition trust fund for the tuition programs provided for in chapters  
2 37-07.1 and 37-07.2 for the biennium beginning July 1, 1997, and ending June 30, 1999.

3 **SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION.** There is hereby appropriated any funds received by  
4 the adjutant general from federal and private sources for the purpose of operating the North  
5 Dakota veterans' cemetery at or adjacent to Fort Abraham Lincoln state park for the biennium  
6 beginning July 1, 1997, and ending June 30, 1999.
