ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1021

Introduced by

(At the request of the Governor)

1 A BILL for an Act to make an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state game and
2 fish department.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the
5 funds as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the game and fish
6 fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from
7 federal funds and other income, to the state game and fish department for the purpose of
8 defraying the expenses of the various divisions of the department, for the biennium beginning
9 July 1, 1997, and ending June 30, 1999, as follows:

23 **SECTION 2. HABITAT RESTORATION.** The amount of \$650,000, or such lesser
24 amount as may be available, for the line item entitled wildlife habitat in section 1 of this Act, is

1 from the habitat restoration stamp program fund, to lease privately owned lands for wildlife
2 habitat to reestablish wildlife population for the biennium beginning July 1, 1997, and ending
3 June 30, 1999. These funds may be spent only for the purposes and using guidelines
4 contained in section 20.1-03-12.1.

5 **SECTION 3. LAND HABITAT AND DEER DEPREDATION.** The amount of
6 \$1,000,000, or such lesser amount as may be available, for the line item entitled land habitat
7 and deer depredation in section 1 of this Act, is from the private land habitat improvement fund
8 to improve wildlife habitat on private land and alleviate depredation as provided in section
9 20.1-02-05 for the biennium beginning July 1, 1997, and ending June 30, 1999.

10 **SECTION 4. NONGAME WILDLIFE.** The amount of \$45,000, or such lesser amount
11 as may be available, for the line item entitled nongame wildlife in section 1 of this Act, is from
12 the nongame wildlife fund for the purpose of preservation, inventory, perpetuation, and
13 conservation of nongame wildlife, natural areas, and nature preserves in this state for the
14 biennium beginning July 1, 1997, and ending June 30, 1999.

15 **SECTION 5. SMALL AND BIG GAME RESTORATION FUND.** The amount of
16 \$400,000, or such lesser amount as may be available, for the line item entitled small and big
17 game restoration trust in section 1 of this Act, is from the small and big game restoration trust
18 fund to improve wildlife habitat on private land for the biennium beginning July 1, 1997, and
19 ending June 30, 1999.
