

HOUSE BILL NO. 1022

- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state historical
2 society and the international peace garden.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the
5 funds as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in
6 the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal
7 funds and from other income, to the state historical society for the purpose of defraying the
8 expenses of its divisions, for the biennium beginning July 1, 1997, and ending June 30, 1999,
9 as follows:

4 **SECTION 2. FUNDING - INTERNATIONAL PEACE GARDEN.** The superintendent of
5 the state historical society shall transfer fifty percent of the amount appropriated in the
6 international peace garden line item in subdivision 2 of section 1 of this Act to the international
7 peace garden within ten days of July 1, 1997, and transfer the remaining fifty percent within ten
8 days of July 1, 1998. The state historical society may not reduce the funds appropriated for the
9 international peace garden in subdivision 2 of section 1 of this Act by a percentage greater than
10 any percentage allotment of general fund moneys required of the department pursuant to the
11 provisions of sections 54-44.1-12 and 54-44.1-13.1.
