Date of Request: March 27, 1997

1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, cities, and school districts.

Narrative: This bill provides parents the opportunity of accessing out-of-home treatment services without having to transfer custody of their child to the county or the state. Access would be strictly limited to Medicaid eligible clients. With this restriction, there would be no fiscal impact to the Department of Human Services. Costs would be covered through the Department's existing budget by moving funding from Foster Care to Mental Health, both within Subsection 3 of Section 1, HB 1012.
