1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, cities, and school districts.

Narrative:

Fiscal impact on the General Fund is \$41,669,450. The apportionment of the Oil Extraction Tax Development Fund will be changed. Currently 10% is credited to the Resources Trust Fund. This bill will increase funding to 20%. Based on the Tax Department figures from October 21, 1996, the Resources Trust Fund will increase from approximately \$3,900,000 to \$7,800,000.
