Date of Request: February 3, 1997

- Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, cities, and school districts.

Narrative: The amended bill guarantees that districts reorganized after August 1, 1997 will receive the same per student payments they would have received had they not reorganized for a specified period of time. The amended bill creates a new section extending this protection to cooperating districts that subsequently reorganize for a period of two years.

The language in the amended bill appears to remove the statutory authority to guarantee payments to eligible districts reorganized before August 1, 1997. The fiscal note is prepared on that basis. This affects 4 current reorganized districts and 2 new districts reorganized effective July 1, 1997.
