1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, cities, and school districts.

Narrative: This bill allows reorganized and cooperating districts to continue to receive the same per student (previously only for high school students) payments they would have received had they not reorganized for a specified period. It applies only to districts reorganized after August 1, 1997 and districts cooperating on or after July 1, 1997.

Because the bill does not grandfather in existing reorganized or cooperating districts and newly reorganized or cooperating districts will continue to receive the same per student payments, the fiscal impact of the bill is zero. Potential savings are deferred to the future.
