- Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, cities, and school districts.

Narrative: House Bill 1184 is fiscally neutral. Foundation aid is paid to the educating district, whether or not they are open enrolled or paying tuition. In terms of paying tuition, one district's revenue gain is offset by the expenditure made by the other district.

The bill will have the effect of allowing students from districts that are engaged in cooperative activities to open enroll on a K-12 basis from either district.
