Like HB 1166, this bill permits the court to assess fifteen dollar costs payable to the county in criminal, as well as civil, insufficient fund cases.

The fiscal impact of HB 1238 is unknown because the number of criminal cases for issuing a check without sufficient funds is unknown. The fifteen dollar assessment is payable to the county so all revenue generated will go to the county.
