1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, cities, and school districts.

Narrative: This bill increases the amount that can be expended from a deceased Medicaid recipient's estate for funeral expenses from \$1,400 to \$3,000 when that recipient leaves no prepayments or deposits designated for burial expenses or leaves prepayments or deposits totaling less than \$3,000. The decrease in estate collections which are used to offset expenditures are undeterminable.
