- Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, cities, and school districts.

Narrative: Currently North Dakota school districts pay the following amounts in tuition to other North Dakota districts: Kindergarten \$250,800, Elementary \$8,470,399, Junior High \$942,907, and Secondary \$3,542,278. There is no way to determine how many districts would use the authority provided for House Bill 1321 nor to determine the degree to which they would use the authority to charge higher levels of tuition. In any case there would be no fiscal impact to the state of North Dakota since it would not change foundation aid or transportation payments. There would be potential fiscal impact on school districts who were charged higher tuition.
