It is not possible to accurately estimate the number of those to whom marriage licenses are issued who may fail to obtain the premarital counseling certificate required by HB 1361. Therefore, the fiscal affect upon the children's trust fund is unknown. Informational note: In 1995, 4,613 marriage licenses were filed with the Vital Records, Division of the Department of Health (1996 statistics are not yet available).
