Date of Request: 3-19-97

1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, cities, and school districts.

Narrative: HB 1364, if enacted with amendments to the first engrossment, exempts park model mobile homes that have paid a twenty dollar park model trail fee from property taxes for tax years 1997 and 1998. There are approximately 20 park model units in North Dakota at the current time and this number is projected to grow at a ten percent annual rate. Removing property from the assessment rolls has a negative effect on the property tax revenue for the state medical center levy, counties, and school districts. Park model units are usually not located within city limits.

Note: The amendment to the first engrossment provides clarification and does not change the fiscal impact.
