1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, cities, and school districts.

Narrative: Currently a nonresident upland game hunter pays a total of \$83 for licenses. A waterfowl license costs an additional \$10 for a total of \$93. This bill changes the license structure and fees so that a nonresident who hunts upland game only will pay \$173. To hunt only waterfowl the fee will be \$173. To hunt both upland game and waterfowl the cost will be \$263. This large fee increase will decrease license sales, possibly by 50 percent or more. Total revenue could decrease somewhat.
