Narrative:

HB 1420 would increase the fee received by the clerk of court for filing, preparing, certifying, issuing, or certifying certain miscellaneous documents. Relevant data is not maintained by the judiciary and is not readily available elsewhere. The fiscal impact of HB 1420 is, therefore, unknown. However, HB 1420 would generally result in increased fee revenue received by the clerk of court, which would be retained by the county.
