1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, cities, and school districts.

Narrative: This fiscal note includes costs to DHS only as both the Health Department and the Board of Nursing have indicated the fiscal impact would be less than \$5,000 each. The amendment deleted the language "to two or more clients"; consequently, more providers would be required to register. We estimate the 800 increased registrations would require an additional .9 FTE for 3 months during the implementation period and an additional .25 FTE for the remainder of the biennium along with associated operating costs.
