Narrative:

This fiscal note is compiled assuming the new Pardon Advisory Board would meet three times a year or six meetings a biennium. None of the current Parole or Pardon appointed members live in Bismarck, ND. I am assuming a 400 mile round trip average per Pardon Advisory Board member. I also included one overnight stay per member per meeting. The calculations are based on the present state rates. The bill does not address a daily stipend, therefore, none was included.
