**Narrative:**

SB 2091 as originally submitted would have allowed the State of North Dakota to receive royalties on SIBR (the Statewide Integrated Budget and Reporting System developed by OMB during this biennium) if the company who built the system was awarded business to build budget systems in other states. The bill, as amended, requires OMB to license, patent, or copyright SIBR before receiving royalties. OMB will not be licensing, patenting, or copyrighting SIBR due to the liability issues associated with the sale of copyright materials.
