- Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, cities, and school districts.

**Narrative:** Currently there are three federal savings associations in North Dakota. The likely scenario is that only one of the three may convert to a state-chartered bank. The upper range figure takes into consideration the impact of the one conversion taking place by using existing assets and the assessment formula. Revenue and expense monies would offset each other as the Department is 100% self-supporting. The Department does not anticipate the need for additional FTE's and present staff could handle any additional responsibilities in the immediate future.


