- 1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, and cities.

Narrative:

SB 2281 would remove the requirement that counsel be appointed for an indigent party in a proceeding leading to a paternity determination. This is a cost currently borne by the counties. A random survey indicates only a few cases in which counsel has been appointed and then paid for by the county; specific dollar amounts were not available. Therefore, although the specific fiscal impact of SB 2281 is unknown, there would likely be a small cost savings for the counties.
