- Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, cities, and school districts.

Narrative: The bill apparently requires the Department to redo rules/regulations promulgated in the past as well as placing future rule/regulation making under the administrative code. It is difficult to estimate what the cost of this bill will be but considering the cost of hearings, including advertising, travel, etc., the rules making process is estimated to cost \$10,000 for each set of rules promulgated. A reasonable estimate for rules for redoing old rules as well as rules for new sections of code might well be \$100,000 for the next biennium.
