SUMMARY OF ACTUARIAL INFORMATION

BILL DESCRIPTION: **Presumption Clause - Physical exam requirements for full-time paid firefighters and law enforcement officers**

BILL NO: Reengrossed SB 2343

SUMMARY OF ACTUARIAL INFORMATION: The Workers Compensation Bureau, together with its Actuary, Glenn Evans of Pacific Actuarial Consultants, has reviewed the legislation proposed in this bill in conformance with Section 54-03-25 of the North Dakota Century Code.

Proposed bill changes physical exam requirements for employers of full-time paid firefighters and law enforcement officers from the current annual requirement to require medical evaluations every 5 years for 1 to 10 years of service, every 3 years for 11 to 20 years of service, and every year for those with 21 or more years of service as a full-time paid firefighter or law enforcement officer.

FISCAL IMPACT: No impact. Will reduce administrative burden for employers of full-time paid firefighters and law enforcement officers.

AMENDMENT: The amendment is an amendment in the alternative to ensure that if the presumption clause is relocated within the Code as proposed by House Bill No. 1269, the changes proposed in Senate Bill No. 2343 will be reflected in that new section.

Amendment will result in no change to the impact for the reengrossed bill.
