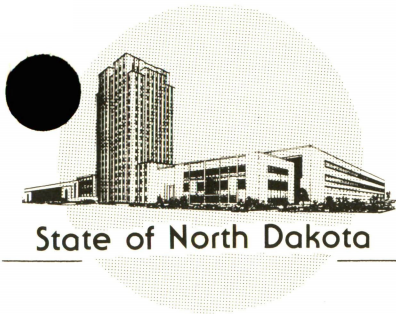

Fiscal Note

SB 2379

SB 2379 should carry no fiscal note. The terms construction administration and construction observation services are found in both architects' and engineers' standard contract text, and are generally performed as part of the standard services outlined in the contract. The inclusion of the language clears up the duties of the architect or engineer who has been retained for the particular project.

One note of caution: While remote, there is the possibility that this could be misinterpreted to mean that a separate architect or engineer should be retained to perform those functions. If that happens and the design architect or engineer does not reduce their fee accordingly the fiscal note could be up to 1.6% of the gross value of the project.
