1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, cities, and school districts.

Narrative:

The fiscal impact of the premium tax credit allowed under this measure would be a maximum reduction to the general fund of \$1 million per year, or \$2 million per biennium. It is anticipated that the Insurance Commissioner's role in administering the provisions of this measure would have no fiscal impact on the Insurance Department.

This measure appears to be designed to develop economic growth in cities and counties; however, we have no data on which to base an estimate of the fiscal impact on these entities.
