CORRECTION AND REVISION OF THE JOURNAL

Reps. Lloyd, Aarsvold and Sens. G. Nelson, Wogsland introduced:

HB 1339: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 4-09-08, 4-09-10, 4-09-14.3, 4-10.3-01, 4-10.3-02, 4-10.3-03, 4-10.3-04, 4-10.3-05, 4-10.3-08, 4-10.3-09, 4-24-09, and 4-24-10 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the North Dakota dry bean council and the assessment on dry beans; to provide an effective date; and to declare an emergency.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Agriculture Committee**.

Reps. Sandvig, Koppelman, Boehm and Sens. Christmann, Kelsh, Wanzek introduced:

HB 1340: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact paragraph 5 of subdivision d of subsection 1 of section 57-38-01.2 and subsection 5 of section 57-38-30.3 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to income tax deductions or credits for adoption expenses; and to provide an effective date.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Finance and Taxation Committee**.

Reps. Nichols, Wardner, Brown and Sen. Kinnoin introduced:

HB 1341: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 57-15-01.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to establishing values for property exempt from property taxes.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Finance and Taxation Committee**.

SB 2010: A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the council on the arts and an appropriation of funds from the cultural endowment fund.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Appropriations Committee**.

SB 2035: A BILL for an Act to repeal sections 38-14.1-04.1, 38-14.1-04.2, and 38-14.1-04.3 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the reclamation research advisory committee.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Natural Resources Committee**.

SB 2104: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 61-02-08 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to meetings of the state water commission.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Natural Resources Committee**.

SB 2105: A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 61-02-64.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the purpose of the contract fund.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Natural Resources Committee**.

SB 2107: A BILL for an Act to repeal section 38-08-06.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the industrial commission's responsibilities pursuant to the Natural Gas Policy Act of 1978.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Natural Resources Committee**.
