

**HOUSE BILL NO. 1063**

1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15-36 of the North Dakota  
2 Century Code, relating to provisional teaching certificates.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15-36 of the North Dakota Century Code is  
5 created and enacted as follows:

- 6 1. The education standards and practices board may issue provisional certification:  
7 a. To an individual who has applied for a teaching certificate if, on or after  
8 August fifteenth, the superintendent of a school district that intends to hire the  
9 individual as a teacher files a petition for provisional certification with the  
10 education standards and practices board; and  
11 b. To an individual whose teaching certificate expires during the school year, if  
12 the individual is not covered by those provisions of section 15-36-12 which  
13 relate to the expiration of a teaching certificate.  
14 2. Under provisional certification, an individual may perform all duties otherwise  
15 performed by a certificated teacher.  
16 3. Provisional certification is valid for thirty instructional days, beginning with the first  
17 instructional day after the date of issuance.  
18 4. If an individual is denied a teaching certificate within the period of provisional  
19 certification, the provisional certification is immediately revoked.
