

**SENATE BILL NO. 2309**

1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subdivision a of subsection 1 of section 43-25-07 of the  
2 North Dakota Century Code, relating to school of massage therapy accreditation standards.

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subdivision a of subsection 1 of section 43-25-07 of the  
5 1997 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

6 a. Presents a diploma or credentials issued by a school of massage that meets  
7 the standards set by the board; which may not be less than the standards of  
8 the American massage therapy association commission on massage therapy  
9 accreditation but which must require at least seven hundred fifty hours of  
10 classroom instruction; or if the board has not adopted standards, the school of  
11 massage meets the curriculum guidelines of the American massage therapy  
12 association commission on massage therapy accreditation and the school  
13 requires at least seven hundred fifty hours of supervised classroom  
14 instruction.
