1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 15-47-15 of the North Dakota Century Code, or
2 in the alternative to amend and reenact section 15.1-09-34 of the North Dakota Century Code,
3 relating to bidding for school district employee group health plans; and to provide a penalty.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** If House Bill No. 1034 does not become effective, section
6 15-47-15 of the 1997 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and
7 reenacted as follows:

8 **15-47-15. School contracts - Advertisement for bids - Publication - Exceptions -**
9 **Penalty.**

10 1. Except as provided in this section, a school board may not enter into a contract
11 involving the expenditure of an aggregate amount greater than eight thousand
12 dollars unless the school board has given ten days' notice by at least one
13 publication in the official newspaper of the school district, received sealed bids, and
14 accepted the bid of the lowest responsible bidder who in the opinion of the school
15 board will best serve the interests of the school district. The provisions of this
16 section do not apply to contracts for:

17 ~~1.~~ a. ~~Personal~~ Contracts for the personal services of employees of the district.

18 ~~2.~~ b. ~~School~~ Contracts for the purchase of school textbooks or reference books.

19 ~~3.~~ c. ~~Articles~~ The purchase of articles not sold on the open market.

20 ~~4.~~ d. ~~Patented~~ The purchase of patented, copyrighted, or exclusively sold devices
21 or features required to match articles already in use.

22 ~~5.~~ e. ~~Patented~~ The purchase of patented, copyrighted, or exclusively sold articles
23 so distinctive that only one brand can be purchased.

24 ~~6.~~ f. Building contracts under chapters 48-01.1 and 48-02.

- 2 school district employee health plan may be of a duration greater than six years.
- 3 3. A board member who participates in a violation of this section is guilty of a class B
- 4 misdemeanor.
