

SENATE BILL NO. 2357

1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subdivision g of subsection 5 of section 39-24-09 and
2 section 39-24-11 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to prohibited operation of
3 snowmobiles and penalties governing the operation of snowmobiles.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subdivision g of subsection 5 of section 39-24-09 of the
6 North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

7 g. Upon any private land where the private land is posted by the owner or tenant
8 prohibiting trespassing. The name ~~and address~~ of the person posting the
9 land ~~and the date of posting~~ must appear on each sign in legible characters.
10 The posted signs must be readable from the outside of the land and must be
11 placed conspicuously at a distance of not more than eight hundred eighty
12 yards [804.68 meters] apart, provided further that as to land entirely enclosed
13 by a fence or other enclosure, posting of ~~such~~ signs at or on all gates through
14 ~~such~~ the fence or enclosure ~~must be construed to be~~ constitutes a posting of
15 all ~~such~~ the enclosed lands.

16 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 39-24-11 of the North Dakota Century Code is
17 amended and reenacted as follows:

18 **39-24-11. Penalties.** Any person who violates subdivision b ~~or g~~ of subsection 5 of
19 section 39-24-09 is guilty of a class B misdemeanor. Any person who violates subdivision g of
20 subsection 5 of section 39-24-09 is guilty of a class A misdemeanor. Any person who violates
21 subdivision c of subsection 5 of section 39-24-09 is guilty of an infraction or a class B
22 misdemeanor as determined by section 39-24.1-07. Any person who violates subsection 11 of
23 section 39-24-09 is guilty of a class B misdemeanor and must be assessed a fine of at least
24 one hundred dollars. Any person who violates any other provision of section 39-24-09 must be

1 assessed a fee of twenty dollars. Any person, unless specifically exempted, who fails to
2 register as required by section 39-24-02 must be assessed a fee of fifty dollars. If the person
3 provides proof of registration after the violation, the fee may be reduced by one-half. Any
4 person who violates any other provision of this chapter for which a specific penalty is not
5 provided must be assessed a fee of ten dollars.
