

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3015

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Council to study the feasibility and desirability
2 of establishing house subdistricts within senatorial districts when the legislative assembly
3 redistricts after the 2000 census.

4 **WHEREAS**, the Constitution of North Dakota requires the Legislative Assembly to
5 redistrict after each federal decennial census; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the Constitution of North Dakota allows for the election of house members
7 from subdistricts or at large; and

8 **WHEREAS**, the creation of subdistricts within senatorial districts may be particularly
9 desirable in geographically large rural districts, but less desirable in more compact urban
10 districts;

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**
12 **OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

13 That the Legislative Council study the feasibility and desirability of establishing house
14 subdistricts within senatorial districts when the Legislative Assembly redistricts after the 2000
15 census; and

16 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Council report its findings and
17 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
18 the Fifty-seventh Legislative Assembly.
