ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 2008

1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the public service
2 commission; and to amend and reenact section 49-01-05 of the North Dakota Century Code,
3 relating to the salary of public service commissioners.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the
6 funds as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in
7 the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal
8 funds and other income, to the public service commission for the purpose of defraying the
9 expenses of the public service commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 1999, and
10 ending June 30, 2001, as follows:

19 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 49-01-05 of the 1997 Supplement to the North
20 Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

21 **49-01-05. Salary of commissioners.** The annual salary of a commissioner is ~~fifty-five~~
22 fifty-eight thousand four hundred sixty-four ~~sixty-two~~ dollars through June 30, ~~1998~~ 2000,
23 fifty-nine thousand four hundred twenty-eight dollars through December 31, 2000, and
24 ~~fifty-seven~~ sixty-four thousand one hundred twenty-six ~~two~~ sixty-nine dollars thereafter. All fees

- 1 received or charged by any commissioner for any act or service rendered in any official
- 2 capacity, must be accounted for and paid over by the commissioner monthly to the state
- 3 treasurer and must be credited to the general fund of the state.
