1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 23-07-17.1 of the North Dakota
2 Century Code, relating to the place of filing certification of inoculation for a child receiving
3 home-based instruction.

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 1 of section 23-07-17.1 of the 1997
6 Supplement to the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

7 1. ~~No~~ A child may not be admitted to any public, private, or parochial school, or day
8 care center, child care facility, headstart program, or nursery school operating in
9 ~~North Dakota~~ this state or be supervised through home-based instruction unless
10 ~~such~~ the child's parent or guardian presents to the institution authorities a
11 certification from a licensed physician or authorized representative of the state
12 department of health that ~~such~~ the child has received immunization against
13 diphtheria, pertussis, tetanus, measles, rubella (German measles), mumps, and
14 poliomyelitis. In the case of a child receiving home-based instruction, the child's
15 parent or legal guardian shall file the certification with the ~~superintendent of public~~
16 ~~instruction~~ public school district in which the child resides.
