Narrative:

The amendment to HB1122 adds mobility impaired individuals to the definition of "communications impaired", which may increase demand for telecommunications equipment under this program. It also adds the definition of disadvantaged which may reduce the number of individuals qualified to receive telecommunications equipment under this program. Based on conversations with other states and the contracted vendor, the program administrator believes the net effect of these changes will be budget neutral.
