1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, cities, and school districts.

**Narrative:** This bill takes care of several housekeeping items related to Central Services. This fiscal note reflects the additional revenue and expenditures incurred if Surplus Property is allowed to purchase federal property and then sell it. It also reflects revenue and expenditures incurred if political subdivisions disposed of their property with Surplus Property. Those fiscal effects are included in the agency budget.

The general fund revenue increase is a result of increased registrations with the Secretary of State.
