1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, cities, and school districts.

**Narrative:**

This bill requires approximately 10,000 businesses to pay a fee and register as sellers of volatile substances. The Department of Human Services shall conduct a media campaign for \$164,000 and provide grants of \$94,000 for prevention and awareness of volatile chemicals. The Department of Health shall educate and inspect the businesses on the applicability of the law and design and provide signs for posting near volatile chemical plants (approximate cost of \$258,000). The total cost of the bill is \$516,000.


