1. Please estimate the fiscal impact (in dollar amounts) of the above measure for state general or special funds, counties, cities, and school districts. .

Narrative:

This bill prohibits the Department of Transportation from issuing a new license plate design during the next biennium and provides for the issuance of a commemorative Lewis and Clark license plate to be issued. It is not possible to estimate the revenue gain from the sale of the commemorative license plates because it is not possible to determine the number of vehicle owners who will choose to purchase the plates. The prohibition against a new license plate design would most likely result in a reduction of \$2,800,000 for the Motor Vehicle Division 1999-2001 budget.
